WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD/WARD IS ABSENT

- Contact the main office on 0151 922 3798 and then dial extension 219 or 205
- Contact the school on the first day of absence and every following day until they return
- When your child/ward returns please send them in with a note explaining the reason for their absence
- If appropriate please provide a medical note or appointment card
- If we do not have a reason for absence your child/ward will receive an unauthorised mark (0)
- There are sanctions in place in school for unexplained and unauthorised absences
- Unauthorised absences can result in action from the Education Welfare Officer including fines and possible Court action
- In the event of an unexplained absence you will be informed automatically by a text/home visit
- This communication is a vital part of our commitment to the safety of your child/ward
- In order for the system to be effective we must have an up-to-date telephone number to contact you during the school day
- Please ensure you notify the school of any changes to your contact details (particularly mobile telephone numbers) as soon as possible
- It is vital that your child/ward is in registration in order to avoid an unnecessary call from the Attendance Officers
